



### Scenario

The Happy Family moved from Kearney, Nebraska to New Castle, Colorado because close family friends told them that Osage Organic Greenhouse is hiring. The greenhouse will start hiring sometime in September.

The Happy family has two children; Joy is 15- years- old, and her birthdate is January 24, 1999. Always is their 14-year-old son and his birthdate is February 28, 2000.

In Nebraska, the children attended Bell Hope High School. Joy would sometimes work with her father, Feliz, at the Steinbrink Tree farm. Her mom, Merry worked at the same tree farm. Feliz and Merry both worked at Steinbrink's from February 13, 2013-August 23, 2013. They move with the children to New Castle, Colorado and arrive on September 3, 2013.

Feliz applies at the greenhouse and is hired on September 21, 2013. He will be working 30 hours a week until January. Merry also applied at the same time but is not hired. Merry continues to look for work around New Castle and is hired at a family nursery, owned by the Cranky Family. She will be transplanting and seeding for the next two months. She is hired on September 29, 2013. Feliz is enjoying his new job. Merry is finding it difficult to work with the owner, Mr. Cranky. She shares with her husband Feliz that she can't handle working for Mr. Cranky. Feliz who sees the good in everything tries to give Merry some pointers to deal with Mr. Cranky.

After two weeks of working with the Cranky Nursery, Merry quits but is able to find a job at the local motel as a maid.

Mr. Happy and his family are unsure what they will do after the work is completed but if they are unable to find work in New Castle, they will move on... happily.
