



## The Now Wow Family Scenario

The Now Wow Family just arrived in your area on December 1, 2013. They have seven children and are currently staying at the Drop Down Motel at 1222 E. Colfax, Ave. Aurora Colorado 80011.

You were contacted by someone from the school district because the family needs support services and better suitable housing.

The seven children are:

Aayo Now Wow, born in Salem, Oregon, and her birthday is January 17, 2006.

Sha Sha Now Wow, born in Yakima, Washington and his birthday is January 17, 2007.

Bae Bae Wow, born in Vietnam and his birthday is December 3, 1993. He has his high school diploma.

Sae Sae Now Wow, born in Yakima, Washington and his birthday is December 19, 1998. Sae Sae has dropped out of school to help support the family.

Sae Bae Naj Wow was also born in Yakima, Washington and her birthday is January 2, 1999.

Lai Lai Now Wow is the newest addition to the family, and he was born one month after they arrived in Aurora, Colorado.

Taa Bae Now Wow was born in Salem, Oregon, and he was born two days after Sae Sae. He is three years old and born in Salem, Oregon.

When Mr. Now Wow lived in Yakima, Washington he picked apples and crated them to ship. He worked for Yakima Valley Apples. Mr. and Mrs. Now also lived in Salem, Oregon where they both worked in the mushroom farm for nine months. When they finished the work on November 15, 2013, they decided to move to try and find work.

Mrs. Now's family who lives in Thornton, Colorado told her and her husband that Welby's Nursery is going to start hiring in February or March, but they must apply for the work in December. They both apply for work at Welby's Garden and get hired.

<b>Age:</b> The child(ren) is(are) younger than 22.		
<b>School Completion:</b> The child is eligible for a free public education through grade 12 under state law.		
<b>Move:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The child moved on his or her own as a migratory agricultural worker/migratory fisher OR the child moved with or to join/precede a parent, spouse, or guardian who is a migratory agricultural worker/migratory fisher, <b>AND</b></li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The move was from one school district to another, <b>AND</b></li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The move was due to economic necessity, <b>AND</b></li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The move occurred within the past 36 months</li> </ul>		
<b>Purpose of the Move:</b> One purpose of the worker’s move was to seek or obtain qualifying work: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The worker moved to obtain qualifying work and obtained it, <b>OR</b></li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The worker moved to obtain any work and obtained qualifying work soon after the move, <b>OR</b></li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The worker moved for qualifying work specifically, but did not obtain the work, <b>AND</b></li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The worker has a prior history of moves to obtain qualifying work <b>OR</b></li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There is other credible evidence that the worker actively sought qualifying work soon after the move</li> </ul>		
<b>Qualifying Work:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The employment is seasonal or temporary <b>AND</b></li> <li>The work is agricultural or fishing.</li> </ul>		
<b>Do the children qualify? Why or why not?</b>		
<b>Are there additional questions the recruiter should ask?</b>		
<b>Are there other resources or services that might be provided?</b>
